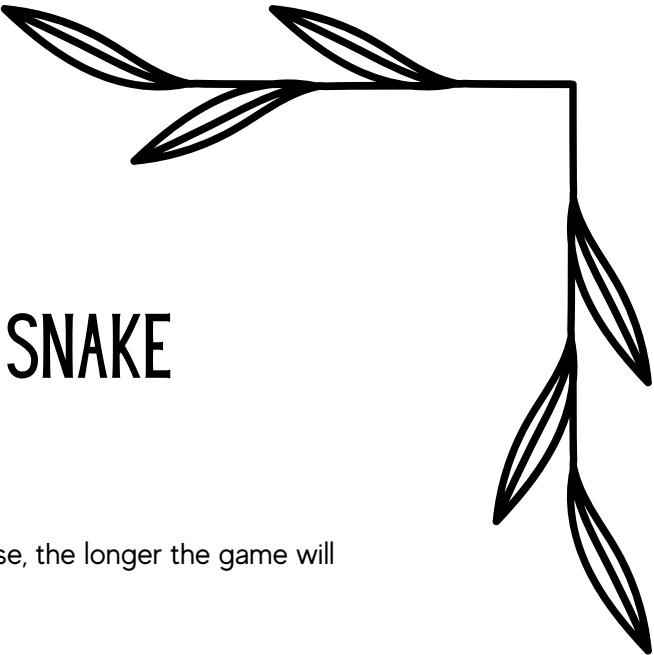
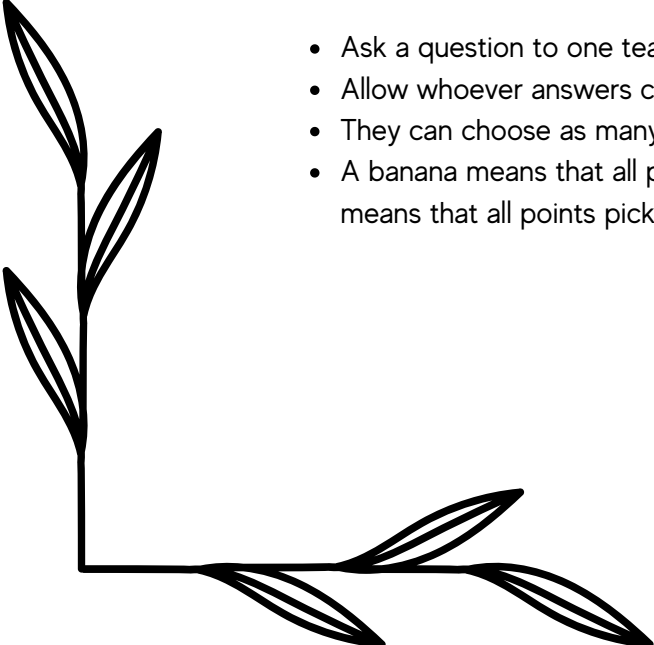




BANANA BANANA SNAKE

PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Print out monkeys. (The more monkeys you use, the longer the game will take.)
- Print out the snakes and bananas page.
- Cut out bananas and snakes and glue one or the other onto the back of some of the monkey squares.
- Write point totals on the rest of the monkey squares. Recommendation: Write the points on a sticker or label and attach it to the back of the square so it doesn't bleed through to the other side.
- Optional: Laminate monkey squares to make them last longer.
- If using with a flannelgraph board, hot glue a piece of Velcro on the back of each monkey.
- Print out the spinner. Cut out the arrow and the wheel.
- Optional: Laminate to make them last longer.
- Attach the arrow to the wheel by laying a paper clip in the middle of the wheel. Then stick brad fastener through a loop in the paper clip into the middle of the wheel. Fasten the legs of the brad fastener to secure. Clip the arrow to the other end of the paper clip. (You will probably need to make a whole for the brad fastener first.)



GAME INSTRUCTIONS

- Ask a question to one team.
- Allow whoever answers correctly to come and spin the wheel.
- They can choose as many monkey squares as they wheel says.
- A banana means that all points picked on that turn are doubled. A snake means that all points picked on that turn are canceled out.
