

FROGGIE HOP

PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Print out one frog page. (They are available in black in white or color depending on whether you'd like to print in color or black and white.)
- Cut out frogs, color if necessary (for black and white), and laminate (if you'd like them to last longer).
- If using a flannelgraph board, hot glue a piece of Velcro on the back of the frogs.
- Print and cut out lily pad template. Note: If you're using a flannelgraph board, use lily pad as template to cut out of felt. Cut as many as you feel you will need. The more lily pads, the more time the game can take. If printing on paper, print out as many lily pads as you will need. I recommend coloring them.
- Write point totals on the front of the lily pads.
- Print out the spinner. Cut out the arrow and the wheel.
- Optional: Laminate to make them last longer.
- Attach the arrow to the wheel by laying a paper clip in the middle of the
 wheel. Then stick brad fastener through a loop in the paper clip into the
 middle of the wheel. Fasten the legs of the brad fastener to secure. Clip the
 arrow to the other end of the paper clip. (You will probably need to make a
 whole for the brad fastener first.)

GAME INSTRUCTIONS

- Place lily pads on the board in a random order. They are like the spaces on a board game.
- Designate a frog for each team. Place them before the lily pads start.
- Ask teams a question. Let the one who answers correctly come up and spin
 the wheel. Move their team frog the correct number of lily pads. Wherever
 the frog lands is how many points the team receives.
