PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Print out bowling pins. The more bowling pins, the longer the game will take.
- Write point totals on the back of the bowling pins. Recommendation: Write
 the points on a sticker or label and attach to the back of the shape so it
 doesn't bleed through to the other side.
- Optional: Laminate bowling pins to make them last longer.
- If using with a flannelgraph board, hot glue a piece of Velcro to the back of each pin.
- Print out the spinner. Cut out the arrow and the wheel.
- Optional: Laminate to make them last longer.
- Attach the arrow to the wheel by laying a paper clip in the middle of the
 wheel. Then stick brad fastener through a loop in the paper clip into the
 middle of the wheel. Fasten the legs of the brad fastener to secure. Clip the
 arrow to the other end of the paper clip. (You will probably need to make a
 whole for the brad fastener first.)

GAME INSTRUCTIONS

- Ask a question to one team.
- Allow whoever answers correctly to come and spin the wheel.
- They can choose as many bowling pins as they spin.
- Add up point totals from bowling pins picked.
