## Instructions:

2. Use a knife or razor blade to cut along the dotted lines on "The Law" page (first page).
3. Glue "The Law" page on top of the second page. Don't put glue over the white boxes, or you won't be able to lift the flaps to see the words underneath.

## The Law:

The Law is the commandments God gave to His people the Jews. We read how and why God gave the Law in the books of Genesis and Exodus. We read the Law itself in the books of Exodus through Deuteronomy. Bible scholars classify the Law into three categories: moral laws, ceremonial laws, and judicial laws. Lift the flaps to find out what each category covers.
